Lemon Balm Glycerite Recipe by: Lola Stonehill

The menstruum is 60% glycerin, 20% alcohol, and 20% water. For dried plant, the ratio is 5 parts menstruum to 1 part plant matter. If using fresh lemon balm, the ratio is 2 parts menstruum to 1 part herb.

An example, using dried herb would be as follows:

Weight to Volume ratio: 1:5

Weight of herb: 50 grams

Total menstruum volume: 150 ml glycerin

50 ml alcohol 50 ml water 250 ml total

Mix it up in a blender then store in a sealed glass jar at room temperature and out of the light. (It's not a bad idea to put a piece of waxed paper between the lid and the jar). Give it a good shake at least once every day. After 2 weeks or so you can strain it.
